Night Work, Lane Closures Scheduled for Route 7/Route 690 Interchange Project

Loudoun County is advising motorists of ongoing construction activities, including the installation and adjustment of traffic control devices, along Route 690 (Hillsboro Road); night work and associated lane closures along Route 7 in connection with the Route 7 and the Route 690 Interchange project.

- **Beginning the week of May 25, 2026**, Loudoun County will begin the installation and adjustment of traffic control devices on Route 690 that will impact sidewalks in the vicinity of the bridge over Route 7. Sidewalks in the area will be closed to pedestrian traffic. These measures are necessary to support upcoming bridge reconstruction activities associated with this project. The duration of this construction phase is estimated to occur for up to twelve months.
- **On Monday, June 1, 2026**, lane closures will begin in the evenings outside of peak commute times on Route 7. This construction is associated with the project's stormwater management system and is estimated to last two months. Partial lane closures and shifts will continue during daytime hours as previously communicated. Drivers will see barriers placed along the median to establish and protect the work zone while stormwater work is underway.

Construction is scheduled outside of peak commute times to help minimize disruptions.

Stay Alert

Drivers are advised to use caution when navigating through this area and to adhere to all posted construction signage and instructions. Drivers may experience periodic temporary lane closures, shifts or flagging operations near the construction site. Use extra caution when walking, biking or driving near the site.

Construction areas will be clearly marked. For your safety, please do not enter the construction site or attempt to cross any construction fencing or barriers. Any significant traffic impacts or changes in access will be communicated by the county in advance, when possible, through project updates.

Construction work will be ongoing until the project's substantial completion, currently estimated for winter (January/February/March) 2029.

About the Project

The project will construct the Route 7 at Route 690 interchange, located approximately two miles west of the Route 7 at Route 287 (Berlin Turnpike) interchange and approximately two miles east of the Route 7 at Business Route 7 interchange. The Route 7 and Route 690 interchange will alleviate connectivity issues in the roadway network around Purcellville, reduce through traffic in downtown Purcellville and along a portion of Route 287, and provide a more direct route to destinations north and northwest of Route 7, including Woodgrove High School, Mountain View Elementary School, Hillsboro and Charles Town, WV.

The project has been awarded Virginia Department of Transportation Smart Scale funding.
