Loudoun County Board of Supervisor's Meeting

Please join ***Friends of the Blue Ridge Mountains*** and many other community organizations at the May 4th meeting of the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors (BOS).

The BOS will be debating the instructions to the staff regarding changes in the zoning ordinance affecting the Mountain Overlay District (MOD).

There are proposals to weaken the protections for the mountains including a reduction in the setback for mountain streams from 300 to 100 feet, increasing the amount of land that can be bulldozed without a permit, and allowing an unlimited number of private parties and events at mountain vineyards.

We will have tee shirts for everyone to wear with the message “***Protect Our Mountains***”.
